

Dot-to-Dot Connections Strategy

Purpose: Provides a means by which students can show the connections they have made in a particular topic. This helps to reinforce new learning and connections in a topic whilst putting them in a context.

Description: From a given list of words, students make connections by drawing lines and writing the connections close to the line.

Process:

- Decide on the topic to be analysed.
- Identify key concepts or words which were pertinent throughout the course of the inquiry topic.
- Vary the amount and type so as to differentiate for the students' levels.
- Place the words in random positions over a piece of paper, an example is provided below.
- Distribute to students who will then draw lines between words and write their explanations as to why or how these words connect.
- As an alternative for older students, the list of words only could be provided to the students for the assessment.
