Religion and Society				In Levels 5 & 6, students will develop the knowledge, skills and understandings to enable them to learn how Catholics and other religious traditions celebrate and live out their core beliefs, symbols and social structures.	By the end of Level 8, students will identify the characteristics and lived experience of a variety of religious traditions and explain the role religion plays in society. They articulate what it means to be Catholic in the contemporary world.	By the end of Level 10, students recognise that one's religious community, society and other factors shape the development of personal spirituality and moral code. They explain the importance of ecumenism in developing Christian unity through dialogue. Students identify Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander spiritualities, beliefs and practices and recognise how they contribute to the development of an Australian spirituality.	By the end of Level 12, students identify how the Catholic Tradition, and other religious traditions, respond to the ultimate questions of life. They explain how different traditions and communities support people in their search for meaning.
