

## Question Web Strategy

**Purpose:** A means by which to allow student voice in the inquiry topics by encouraging them to write down all of the different 'wonderings' and questions they have about a topic.

**Description:** A simple graphic organiser structured like a mind map.

**Process:**

- Decide on the topic to be analysed.
- Teacher can model by thinking aloud the way students can ask a variety of questions about the topic.
- It is especially important in Religious Education to model to the students that all types of questions are acceptable, and that teachers have questions too.
- Students then come up with their own wonderings about the topic and note them down on the chart. An example of which is provided below.
- These questions can be used at the planning table by the teacher to help direct the inquiry, including the formulation of inquiry questions, thereby incorporating student voice.
- This can be undertaken by individuals or in groups.
- This strategy can also be used at various points within an inquiry, as a means of engaging student voice.
